ELIGIBILITY:

Anyone who is a member of Jewelers of Louisiana and who owns or is employed in a member store for one or more years. Associate members are not eligible.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

All pieces will be judged on **Overall Design, Marketability, Practicality/Wearability, and Craftsmanship.**

GENERAL RULES:

1. One entry per person in each category, with at least one person from the member's store registered and in attendance at the convention.
2. All entries must be an original design by the designer listed, produced within 18 months of the contest. Piece may have been entered in other competitions but cannot have won any awards.
3. Only precious metals (silver, gold, platinum) may be used. Design pieces must be quality stamped. All stones must be genuine.
4. All entries must be made in accordance with industry standards. No edge weapons or firearms.
5. Jewelers of Louisiana assumes no responsibility when not in their possession.
6. DISPLAYS – Some displays on a limited basis will be supplied. You can bring your own display to show your design (recommended). Display must be in keeping with good taste, fairness, and is subject to refusal by the Associate Member in charge of the contest.
7. All pieces must be picked up following the awards presentations and signed for by the original entrant.
